HELPING NURSERIES SELL MORE PLANTS: IN-STORE TRIAL NOW LIVE

Greener Spaces Better Places is excited to share an update on our **HOW TO GROW** campaign, a trial now live across five participating nurseries nationwide.

Launched earlier this year, the trial is testing whether simple, colour-coded pot stickers - each linked to a QR code and bite-sized plant care video - can help nursery customers buy and grow with confidence.

The campaign focuses on five plant categories:

INDOOR PLANTS, EDIBLES, POTTED COLOUR, NATIVES, AND SUCCULENTS.

WHAT'S HAPPENING IN-STORE?

Point-of-sale posters and creative visual displays helps quide customers to plants in store that the videos speak to. Participating nurseries have been using these posters to create dedicated merchandising displays, grouping the tagged plants together to bring the campaign to life in-store.

HOW IT'S GOING

It's still early days, but initial feedback has been positive. Data is being collected in real time with participating nurseries also gathering qualitative feedback from their teams and customers.
